Symposium FAQ

How do I RSVP?

You will need to register for the event. Please register here: law.tamu.edu/climategoals

When is it?

The symposium is February 24th, 2023. You should check in from 8:30-9:00AM, but should be in your seat by 9:00AM. You may leave early or join late so long as you only do so during the scheduled break periods shown in the agenda.

Where do I go?

The symposium will be in the Lecture Hall. It will also be live-streamed on Zoom. You must register to receive the Zoom link.

Student Publication Opportunity FAQ

What do I submit?

Round 1: Students may work alone or in pairs to submit a *proposal* for their article. The proposal should include:

- An abstract
- An outline of the article (the article must be substantially related to or must critically analyze the symposium overall or a specific panel topic of the symposium)
- A list of sources

Round 2: If selected for publication, you must submit a final article between 2,000 and 5,000 words that includes:

- An abstract
- A table of contents
- Footnotes in Bluebook formatting

How do I submit?

Email your submissions to symposia.editor@lawreview.law.tamu.edu with the subject line “Submission.”

*For those working with a partner, only one person in the pair needs to submit.

When do I submit?

- 1) Proposal submissions will be accepted between February 25th and March 20th.
- 2) Results will be released March 27th.
- 3) If selected, the final draft will be due by April 10th.
