Take-Home Final Exams

Take home exams are administered using the EBB take home exam platform – which is different than the EBB platform for in-class exams. Please consult the [EBB Take Home Exam Instructions](#) for further information.

For each take home exam, listed below is the relevant window during which you may download the exam. The exam is downloaded as a pdf document. You do not need to install EBB software on your computer to access your take-home exams.

Once you download your exam, you will have the amount of time identified below for your exam to complete the exam in a Word document. For exams with a completion time of four hours or less, we will allow an additional 15 minutes for your exam time to allow you to download (and print, if needed) the exam and to upload your exam answers to the EBB platform.

Your exam must be turned in the earlier of (1) the designated time to complete your exam following your check out time or (2) the end of the relevant exam window identified below. Please plan accordingly. For example, if your exam allows 24 hours for completion, but you do not check out the exam until 12 hours prior to the end of the exam window, then you will have only 12 hours to complete your exam. Any exam turned in past the relevant deadline will be marked late for the instructor. Please consult with your instructor for the applicable penalty for late exams.
